She actually wrote Pride and Prejudice, sense and Sensibility and Northanger Abbey all before age 25 and sold Northanger Abbey to a publisher before she was 25. The publisher just sat on it and did not sell it.

Later she published S & S and because of its popularity, she reworked P & P, which she originally called "First Impressions".

then she wrote Mansfield Park and Emma. Last she wrote Persuasion which was published after her death. After her death, her brother bought back the rights to Northanger Abbey and published it. :)
